*Illinois Regulation is a summary of the weekly regulatory decisions of State agencies published in the Illinois Register and action taken by the Illinois General Assembly's Joint Committee on Administrative Rules. Illinois Regulation, also titled The Flinn Report in memory of founding JCAR member Rep. Monroe Flinn, is designed to inform and involve the public in changes taking place in agency administration.*

## New Rules

### ■ STUDENT ASSISTANCE

The ILLINOIS STUDENT ASSISTANCE COMMISSION adopted amendments to 7 Parts: General Provisions (23 IAC 2700; 39 Ill Reg 1049), Illinois National Guard (ING) Grant Program (23 IAC 2730; 39 Ill Reg 1075), Illinois Veteran Grant (IVG) Program (23 IAC 2733; 39 Ill Reg 1085), Monetary Award Program (MAP) (23 IAC 2735; 39 Ill Reg 1094), State Scholar Program (23 IAC 2760; 39 Ill Reg 1107), Minority Teachers of Illinois (MTI) Scholarship Program (23 IAC 2763; 39 Ill Reg 1114) and Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois Program (23 IAC 2764; 39 Ill Reg 1122), all effective 7/1/15. Amendments to Part 2700 require postsecondary institutions that participate in MAP to submit graduation and completion rate data as well as information regarding student advising and

support programs. A change since 1<sup>st</sup> Notice also requires institutions to establish or adopt programs intended to improve MAP recipients' retention and completion rates. The Part 2730 and 2733 rulemakings provide that veterans who qualify for ING or IVG assistance and for benefits under the federal Post-9/11 GI Bill must apply their GI Bill benefits to tuition, fees and other qualifying expenses before using their State benefits. The Part 2735 amendments allow dislocated workers (as defined by the federal Workforce Investment Act of 1998) to be considered for MAP assistance for the 2015-16 and 2016-17 academic years even if they apply after the cutoff date for the general pool of applicants. Dislocated worker applicants will be considered until MAP funds are exhausted or until 8/15.

## Proposed Rulemakings

### ■ VIDEO GAMING

The ILLINOIS GAMING BOARD proposed amendments to Video Gaming (General) (11 IAC 1800; 39 Ill Reg 8363) that cross-reference the Riverboat Gambling Board meeting rules (86 IAC 3000.105) and authorize the Board to ban from involvement in a video gaming operation any individual whose involvement may pose a threat to its integrity, even if that person lacks an ownership interest or "significant interest or control" in the operation. Video gaming operations and licensees may be affected.

**NEW RULES:** Rules adopted by agencies this week. **EMERGENCY RULES:** Adopted for a temporary period not to exceed 150 days.

**PROPOSED RULES:** Rules proposed by agencies this week, commencing a 45-day First Notice period during which public comments must be accepted.

**PEREMPTORY RULES:** Rules adopted without prior public notice or JCAR review as authorized by 5 ILCS 100/5-50.

■ Designates rules of special interest to small businesses, small municipalities, and not-for-profit corporations. Agencies are required to consider comments from these groups and minimize the regulatory burden on them.

### DRIVER'S LICENSES

The SECRETARY OF STATE proposed amendments to Cancellation, Revocation or Suspension of Licenses or Permits (92 IAC 1040; 39 Ill Reg 8372) adding illegal possession of medical cannabis in a motor vehicle to the list of vehicle-related offenses. Penalties are a 6-month license suspension for the first conviction, a 12-month suspension for the second, and revocation for a third or subsequent conviction.

Amendments to Part 2760 remove references to the obsolete Prairie State Achievement Exam. Finally, the amendments to Parts 2763 and 2764 correct and clarify cross-references to federal and State statutes and regulations. Those affected by this rulemaking include applicants for student assistance programs.

The ILLINOIS COMMERCE COMMISSION adopted a new Part titled Rate Case Expense (83 IAC 288; 38 Ill Reg 16456), effective 6/5/15, setting rules for determining what a utility may reasonably pay (and thus recover via its rates as an ordinary and reasonable cost of doing business) during the preparation and presentation of a rate case.
