


Children and Families



Abandoned Babies

Provides information on safe havens where people can leave a newborn baby without legal repercussions; also provides information on adoption and a hotline to call for more information or to find help. 3.69" x 8.5" (6 panel, C-fold)

Provides information about HIV/AIDS, including how the disease is transmitted, how it can be prevented, statistics on the spread of AIDS and a toll-free number to get more information or help. 5.5" x 8.5" (single fold)


Living Will


Protection from Abduction


Saw You in the News



Provides information on significant African American inventors and their inventions by category; used primarily as an educational handout to elementary school students. 4.25" x 11" (double fold)




Do Not Call List






Identity Theft: Protect Yourself






African-American State Legislators






Protecting Our Environment


Senior Citizens




Senior Citizen Guide Cook County & Non-Cook County version
