WHEREAS, Illinois Public Media, as a media organization, has a long history of enriching the State through the arts and classical music, even hosting its own chamber orchestra, the WILL Sinfonietta, in 1937; and

WHEREAS, From its very first broadcast, WILL-AM has upheld the mission of a land-grant university by providing essential information to the agricultural community, which continues to this day with daily programming and podcasts; and

WHEREAS, WILL-FM signed on with the first FM license awarded to a university in 1941; and

WHEREAS, WILL hosted the Allerton Conference for the National Association of Educational Broadcasters in 1948, which later began delivering programs to noncommercial radio stations across the country, becoming the forerunner of NPR and PBS; and

WHEREAS, Mister Rogers Neighborhood debuted on WILL-TV in 1968; the show, along with Sesame Street and local children's shows such as Stories 'n' Stuff, helped build the important educational impact that Illinois Public Media continues to provide to children today; and

WHEREAS, Illinois Public Media continues a rich tradition of state-focused, locally-hosted news programs with The 21st radio talk show, which brings listeners the news, culture, and stories that matter to a statewide audience; and

WHEREAS, Illinois Public Media produces award-winning local programming on WILL-TV, WILL-AM, and WILL-FM, focused on news, arts, and the unique history and culture of our State; and

WHEREAS, Today, Illinois Public Media has donors in every region of the State as well as a global audience; and

WHEREAS, Illinois Public Media has been an integral part of the community for 100 years, providing free services to all, and, to this day, remains focused on using the power of public media to educate, inform, and inspire the people of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Illinois Public Media will celebrate the 100th anniversary of WILL-AM on April 6, 2022; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare April 6, 2022 as Illinois Public Media Day in the State of Illinois in celebration of WILL's 100-year history and its profound impact on the community; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to Illinois Public Media with our sincere appreciation for their efforts.

Having been reproduced, the following bill was taken up, read by title a second time and held on the order of Second Reading: SENATE BILL 1693.
