CHANGE OF SPONSORSHIP

With the consent of the affected members, Representative Howard was removed as principal sponsor, and Representative Graham became the new principal sponsor of HOUSE RESOLUTION 628.

With the consent of the affected members, Representative Holbrook was removed as principal sponsor, and Representative Currie became the new principal sponsor of HOUSE BILL 664.

With the consent of the affected members, Representative May was removed as principal sponsor, and Representative Currie became the new principal sponsor of SENATE BILL 77.

AGREED RESOLUTIONS

SENATE BILL ON SECOND READING

SENATE BILL 211. Having been read by title a second time on August 2, 2007, and held on the order of Second Reading, the same was again taken up and advanced to the order of Third Reading.

SENATE BILL ON THIRD READING

The following bill and any amendments adopted thereto were reproduced. Any amendments still pending upon the passage or defeat of a bill on Third Reading are automatically tabled pursuant to Rule 40(a).

On motion of Representative Hassert, SENATE BILL 211 was taken up and read by title a third time. A three-fifths vote is required.
