H.R. 1317 -- Ford --- Designates the portion of Roosevelt Road from Cicero Avenue to Austin Avenue in Chicago as Muhammad Ali Road. (Executive RBA)

H.R. 1349 -- Sims - Nekritz - Gordon-Booth - Ford - Cassidy --- Urges the members of the 114th Congress to appropriate funding to allow the CDC to recognize and study gun violence as a public health crisis. Commends the action of the American Medical Association in officially recognizing gun violence as a public health crisis requiring action by the federal government. (Judiciary - Criminal RBA)
