Findley, Resolved by the House of Representatives of the 82nd General Assembly of the State of Illinois, the Senate concurring herein, that there shall be submitted to electors of the state for adoption or rejection at the General Election next occurring at least six months after the adoption of this Resolution a proposition to amend Section 3 of Article IV of the Constitution to read follows: Article IV. the Legislature, Section З, Legislative Redistricting; (A) Legislative Districts shall be compact, contiguous and substantially equal population. Representative Districts shall be compact, contiquous substantially and equal in population. Legislative and Representative Districts shall, (1) be as reasonably compact in territorial area as is feasible, contain as closely united continuously having vital representative communication with the whole of its area. and (3) maintain the integrity of traditional boundary lines of units of local governments where possible of natural and historic boundaries where feasible. (B) Τn the year following each federal decennial census year, the General Assembly, by law, shall redistrict the Legislative Districts and the Representative Districts. redistricting plan becomes effective by June 30 of that a Legislative Redistricting Commission shall be continued... constituted no later than July 10. The Commission shall consist of eight members, no more than four of whom shall be members of the same political party. Speaker and Minority Leader of the House of Representatives shall each appoint to the Commission one

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Representative and one person who is not a Member of the General Assembly. The President and Minority Leader of the Senate shall each appoint to the Commission one Senator and one person who is not a Member of the General Assembly. The Members shall be certified to the Secretary of State by the appointing authorities. A vacancy on the Commission shall be filled within five days by the authority that made the original appointment. A Chairman and Vice Chairman shall be chosen by a majority of all members of the Commission. Not later than August 10, the Commission shall file with the Secretary of State a redistricting plan approved by at least five members. If the Commission fails to file an approved redistricting plan, the Supreme Court shall submit the names of two persons, not of the same political party, to the Secretary of State, not later than September 1. Not later than September 5, the Secretary of State publicly shall draw, by random selection, the name of one of two persons to serve as the ninth member of the Commission. Not later than October 5, the Commission shall file with the Secretary of State a redistricting plan approved by at least five members. Αn approved redistricting plan filed with the Secretary of State shall be presumed valid, shall have the force and effect of law and shall be published promptly by the Secretary of State. Supreme Court shall have original and exclusive jurisdiction over actions concerning redistricting in the House and Senate and shall be initiated in the name of the people of the state by the Attorney General. Schedule: This Amendment to Section 3 of Article IV οf Constitution takes effect on January 1 next occurring after its approval by the electors of this state.
