As the Illinois General Assembly has enacted the State Mandates Act in which the General Assembly states the General Assembly finds that proceeding actions of State Government in specifying the manner, standards and conditions under which public service are rendered to citizens by the political subdivisions of the state on occasion have not resulted in equitable relationship between State Government and its local political subdivisions, some of these actions have dealt in detail with internal management of local government, others have specified the establishment of new services and facilities without providing any new revenue sources or any financial participation by the state in meeting the additional cost, still others have specified the adoption of higher service standards without a full assessment of the impact upon

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local government and tax rates; and whereas, the General Assembly has on repeated occasions enacted legislation which has necessitated the expenditure of funds by local governments without a source of replacement funding, therefore... and which has been specifically exempt from the State Mandates Act. Therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives, of the 84th General Assembly, of the State of Illinois, the Senate concurring herein, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the state for adoption or rejection in the General Election next occurring at least six months after the adoption of this Resolution, a proposition to amend Section VIII of Article IV of the Constitution to read as follows: Section VIII. Passage of Bills. Remove House Joint Resolution Constitutional Amendment #7 from the record. Being no further business, the House now stands adjourned."

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
