Speaker Hannig: "The Eighth Special Session will now come to order. Is there leave to use the Attendance Roll Call from the First Special Session? Leave is granted and a quorum is present. Representative Currie now moves that the Eighth Special Session stand adjourned until Tuesday, July 31, at the hour of 1 p.m. All in favor say 'aye'; opposed 'nay'. The 'ayes' have it. And the Eighth Special Session stands adjourned. Representative Hoffman, for what reason do you rise?"

Hoffman: "Yes, thank you, Mr. Speaker. Just for the purposes of an announcement. I apologize I didn't hear all of Representative Black's comments. I believe that some of 'em had to do with a proposed 30-day budget on... as Amendment #1 to House Bill 3860 that proposed 30-day budget has been filed. In addition, on Friday delivered to all of the various appropriations staffs was a copy of this Amendment #1. So, Representative Black, if you would like to move for immediate consideration of this 30-day budget, I certainly would be in favor of that, assuming that we have 71 people here. Although, I think we only have 67, so we couldn't avert a government shutdown with today's quorum. So, I would ask that at the point when we have the votes that you join with me to avert a government shutdown and pass a 30-day budget as is indicated in Amendment #1 to House Bill 3860."
