SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 45/2-106a

Amends the Nursing Home Care Act. Removes provisions that prohibit the use of resident identification wristlets without a physician's order. Requires identification wristlets to be employed for every resident.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Nursing Home Care Act is amended by changing
5 Section 2-106a as follows:

6 (210 ILCS 45/2-106a)

7 Sec. 2-106a. Resident identification wristlet.

8 Identification wristlets shall be employed for every resident.

9 Each identification wristlet shall ~~No identification wristlets~~
10 ~~shall be employed except as ordered by a physician who~~
11 ~~documents the need for such mandatory identification in the~~
12 ~~resident's clinical record. When identification bracelets are~~
13 ~~required, they must~~ identify the resident's name, and the name,
14 telephone number, and address of the facility issuing the
15 identification wristlet.
