1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 270 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 270, AS AMENDED, by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 3 4 following: "Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Law 5 6 Enforcement Criminal Sexual Assault Investigation Act. 7 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act: "Law enforcement agency" means an agency of this State or 8 unit of local government which is vested by law or ordinance 9 10 with the duty to maintain public order and to enforce criminal laws or ordinances. 11 "Law enforcement officer" or "officer" means any person 12 employed by a State, county, or municipality as a policeman, 13 peace officer, or in a like position involving the enforcement 14 15 of the law and protection of public interest at the risk of the

- alleged violation of Section 11-1.20, 11-1.30, 2 11-1.40,
- 11-1.50, or 11-1.60 of the Criminal Code of 2012 while an 3
- 4 officer is on duty.
- 5 Section 10. Investigation of officer-involved criminal 6 assault; requirements.
- 7 (a) Each law enforcement agency shall have a written policy
- 8 regarding the investigation of officer-involved criminal
- 9 sexual assault that involves a law enforcement officer employed
- 10 by that law enforcement agency.
- officer-involved criminal 11 (b) Each sexual
- 12 investigation shall be conducted by at least 2 investigators or
- 13 an entity comprised of at least 2 investigators, one of whom
- 14 shall be the lead investigator. The lead investigator shall be
- 15 a person certified by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training
- Standards Board as a sexual assault investigator, or similar 16
- training approved by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training 17
- Standards Board or the Department of State Police, or similar 18
- 19 training provided at an Illinois Law Enforcement Training
- Standards Board certified school. No investigator involved in 2.0
- 21 the investigation may be employed by the law enforcement agency
- 22 that employs the officer involved in the officer-involved
- 23 criminal sexual assault, unless the investigator is employed by
- 24 the Department of State Police or a municipality with a
- 25 population of over 1,000,000 and is not assigned to the same

- division or unit as the officer involved in the criminal sexual 1
- 2 assault.
- 3 Section 15. Intra-agency investigations. This Act does not
- 4 prohibit a law enforcement agency from conducting an internal
- investigation into the officer-involved criminal sexual 5
- assault if the internal investigation does not interfere with 6
- the investigation conducted under the requirements of Section 7
- 8 10 of this Act.
- Section 20. Compensation for investigations. Compensation 9
- for participation in an investigation of an officer-involved 10
- 11 criminal sexual assault under Section 10 of this Act may be
- determined in an intergovernmental or interagency agreement.". 12
