SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

520 ILCS 5/2.5

Amends the Wildlife Code. Provides that all crossbows used to hunt in this State must have a minimum peak draw weight of 125 pounds and a maximum draw weight of at least 300 pounds.

1 AN ACT concerning wildlife.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 2.5 as follows:
- 6 (520 ILCS 5/2.5)
- 7 Sec. 2.5. Crossbow conditions. A person may use a crossbow
- 8 if one or more of the following conditions are met:
- 9 (1) the user is a person age 62 and older;
- 10 (2) the user is a person with a disability to whom the
 11 Director has issued a permit to use a crossbow, as provided
- 12 by administrative rule; or
- 13 (3) the date of using the crossbow is during the period
- of the second Monday following the Thanksgiving holiday
- 15 through the last day of the archery deer hunting season
- 16 (both inclusive) set annually by the Director.
- 17 As used in this Section, "person with a disability" means a
- 18 person who has a physical impairment due to injury or disease,
- 19 congenital or acquired, which renders the person so severely
- 20 disabled as to be unable to use a longbow, recurve bow, or
- 21 compound bow. Permits must be issued only after the receipt of
- 22 a physician's statement confirming the applicant is a person
- with a disability as defined above.

- 1 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
- 2 <u>all crossbows used to hunt in this State must have a minimum</u>
- 3 peak draw weight of 125 pounds and a maximum draw weight of at
- 4 least 300 pounds.
