SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 45/2-106a

Amends the Nursing Home Care Act. Removes provisions that prohibit the use of resident identification wristlets without a physician's order. Requires identification wristlets to be employed for every resident.

AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Nursing Home Care Act is amended by changing
Section 2-106a as follows:

6 (210 ILCS 45/2-106a)

7 Sec. 2-106a. Resident identification wristlet. Identification wristlets shall be employed for every resident. 8 9 Each identification wristlet shall No identification wristlets shall be employed except as ordered by a physician who 10 documents the need for such mandatory identification in the 11 resident's clinical record. When identification bracelets are 12 required, they must identify the resident's name, and the name, 13 14 telephone number, and address of the facility issuing the identification wristlet. 15
