1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1277

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1277 by replacing

3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by

5 changing Section 356z.25 as follows:

6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.25)

Sec. 356z.25. Coverage for treatment of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome. A group or individual policy of accident and health insurance or managed care plan that is amended, delivered, issued, or renewed after July 18, 2017 (the effective date of Public Act 100-24) this amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly shall provide coverage for treatment of pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute-onset

- 1 neuropsychiatric syndrome, including, but not limited to, the
- use of intravenous immunoglobulin therapy. A treatment that is 2
- administered or prescribed after July 18, 2017 shall be 3
- 4 covered.
- 5 For billing and diagnosis purposes, pediatric autoimmune
- 6 neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal
- infections and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome 7
- shall be coded as autoimmune encephalitis until a code is 8
- 9 assigned. Coverage under this Section may not be denied due to
- 10 a diagnosis of autoimmune encephalopathy or autoimmune
- 11 encephalitis.
- If, at any time, the Secretary of the United States 12 13 Department of Health and Human Services, or its successor 14 agency, promulgates rules or regulations to be published in the 15 Federal Register or publishes a comment in the Federal Register 16 or issues an opinion, quidance, or other action that would require the State, pursuant to any provision of the Patient 17 Protection and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111-148), 18 including, but not limited to, 42 U.S.C. 18031(d)(3)(B) or any 19 20 successor provision, to defray the cost of any coverage for 2.1 pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute onset 22 23 neuropsychiatric syndrome outlined in this Section, then the 24 insurer cover pediatric autoimmune requirement that an 25 neuropsychiatric disorders associated with streptococcal 26 infections and pediatric acute onset neuropsychiatric syndrome

- is inoperative other than any such coverage authorized under 1
- Section 1902 of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 1396a, and 2
- 3 the State shall not assume any obligation for the cost of
- 4 coverage for pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders
- 5 associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute
- 6 onset neuropsychiatric syndrome.
