Amends the Dietitian Nutritionist Practice Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning unlicensed practice.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Dietitian Nutritionist Practice Act is
5 amended by changing Section 15.5 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 30/15.5)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2023)

8 Sec. 15.5. Unlicensed practice; violation; civil penalty.

9 (a) Any person who practices, offers to practice, attempts
10 to practice, or holds oneself out as being able to provide
11 dietetics and ~~and~~ nutrition services without being licensed
12 under this Act shall, in addition to any other penalty provided
13 by law, pay a civil penalty to the Department in an amount not
14 to exceed \$10,000 for each offense as determined by the
15 Department. The civil penalty shall be assessed by the
16 Department after a hearing is held in accordance with the
17 provisions set forth in this Act regarding the provision of a
18 hearing for the discipline of a licensee.

19 (b) The Department has the authority and power to
20 investigate any and all unlicensed activity.

21 (c) The civil penalty shall be paid within 60 days after
22 the effective date of the order imposing the civil penalty. The
23 order shall constitute a judgment and may be filed and

1 execution had thereon in the same manner as any judgment from
2 any court of record.
