2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Alternate Fuels Act is amended by changing
Section 5 as follows:

6 (415 ILCS 120/5)

7 Sec. 5. Purpose. The The General Assembly declares that it 8 is the public policy of the State to promote and encourage the 9 use of alternate fuel in vehicles as a means to improve air 10 quality in the State and to meet the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 and the federal Energy 11 Policy Act of 1992. The General Assembly further declares that 12 the State can play a leadership role in the development of 13 14 vehicles powered by alternate fuels, as well as in the establishment of the necessary infrastructure to support this 15 16 emerging technology.
