2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2601 on page 1, line
3 8, by replacing "an apparent life-threatening" with "a brief
4 resolved unexplained"; and

5 on page 1, line 11, by replacing "an apparent life-threatening"
6 with "a brief resolved unexplained"; and

7 on page 1, line 13, after "(1)" by inserting the following:
8 "offer to"; and

9 on page 2, by replacing lines 5 through 8 with the following:

10 "Brief resolved unexplained event" means an episode that
11 occurs to a well-appearing infant up to 12 months old who
12 experiences an event that lasts less than a minute and then
13 resolves itself during which the infant exhibits one or more of
14 the following symptoms: blue or pale complexion, absent or
15 irregular breathing, marked change in muscle tone, and altered

2 on page 2, line 13, by replacing "an apparent life-threatening"

5 on page 2, line 16, by replacing "apparent life-threatening"

7 on page 2, line 17, after "(1)" by inserting the following:
8 "offer to"; and

9 on page 3, by replacing lines 8 through 11 with the following:

10 "Brief resolved unexplained event" means an episode that
11 occurs to a well-appearing infant up to 12 months old who
12 experiences an event that lasts less than a minute and then
13 resolves itself during which the infant exhibits one or more of
