### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

25 ILCS 170/11.3

Amends the Lobbyist Registration Act. Provides that it is a violation of the Act for a person registered or required to be registered as a lobbyist under the Act to accept or agree to accept compensation from a State agency, regardless of whether or not such compensation would be for the purpose of lobbying legislative action.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Lobbyist Registration Act is amended by  
5 changing Section 11.3 as follows:

6 (25 ILCS 170/11.3)

7 Sec. 11.3. Compensation from a State agency. It is a  
8 violation of this Act for a person registered or required to be  
9 registered under this Act to accept or agree to accept  
10 compensation from a State agency ~~for the purpose of lobbying~~  
11 ~~legislative action.~~

12 This Section does not apply to compensation (i) that is a  
13 portion of the salary of a full-time employee of a State agency  
14 whose responsibility or authority includes, but is not limited  
15 to, lobbying executive, legislative, or administrative action  
16 or (ii) to an individual who is contractually retained by a  
17 State agency that is not listed in Section 5-15 of the Civil  
18 Administrative Code of Illinois.

19 For the purpose of this Section, "State agency" is defined  
20 as in the Illinois State Auditing Act.
