SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 65/13.2

from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.2

Amends the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act. Provides that the Department of State Police shall, 60 days prior to the expiration of a Firearm Owner's Identification Card, forward by first class mail to each person whose card is to expire instructions for renewal (rather than an application which may be used to apply for renewal of the card). Provides that a holder of a Firearm Owner's Identification Card shall notify the Department of State Police within 10 days of discovering that his or her Firearm Owner's Identification Card has been lost, destroyed, or stolen. Provides that a lost, destroyed, or stolen Firearm Owner's Identification Card is invalid. Provides that the cost for a replacement card shall be \$5 which shall be deposited into the State Police Firearm Services Fund. Effective January 1, 2018.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is
5 amended by changing Section 13.2 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 65/13.2) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.2)

7 Sec. 13.2. Renewal; name or address change; replacement
8 card. The Department of State Police shall, 60 days prior to
9 the expiration of a Firearm Owner's Identification Card,
10 forward by first class mail to each person whose card is to
11 expire a notification of the expiration of the card and
12 instructions for renewal ~~an application which may be used to~~
13 ~~apply for renewal of the card.~~ It is the obligation of the
14 holder of a Firearm Owner's Identification Card to notify the
15 Department of State Police of any address change since the
16 issuance of the Firearm Owner's Identification Card. Whenever
17 any person moves from the residence address named on his or her
18 card, the person shall within 21 calendar days thereafter
19 notify in a form and manner prescribed by the Department of his
20 or her old and new residence addresses and the card number held
21 by him or her. Any person whose legal name has changed from the
22 name on the card that he or she has been previously issued must
23 apply for a corrected card within 30 calendar days after the

1 change. A holder of a Firearm Owner's Identification Card shall
2 notify the Department of State Police within 10 days of
3 discovering that his or her Firearm Owner's Identification Card
4 has been lost, destroyed, or stolen. A lost, destroyed, or
5 stolen Firearm Owner's Identification Card is invalid. The cost
6 for a corrected or replacement card shall be \$5 which shall be
7 deposited into the State Police Firearm Services Fund.
