SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 645/17

Amends the Illinois Livestock Dealer Licensing Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning records and reporting requirements.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Livestock Dealer Licensing Act is amended by changing Section 17 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 645/17) (from Ch. 111, par. 417)
- Sec. 17. Each licensee shall maintain records of each purchase under this Act including identification of livestock purchased, the the name and address of the seller, and the date of purchase, and a record of each sale, including date, buyer, number and identification of animals. All reports of sales of female feeder cattle must be mailed to the Department weekly on forms furnished by the Department.
- These records along with any accompanying health certificates shall be maintained for a period of 3 years.
