2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3737, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment No.
4 1, on page 5, by replacing lines 13 through 15 with the
5 following:

6 "(4) identify information security risks to each State
7 agency, to third-party providers, and to key supply chain
8 partners, including an assessment of the extent to which
9 information resources or processes are vulnerable to
10 unauthorized access or harm, including the extent to which the
11 agency's or contractor's electronically stored information is
12 vulnerable to unauthorized access, use, disclosure,
13 disruption, modification, or destruction, and recommend risk
14 mitigation strategies, methods, and procedures to reduce those
15 risks. These assessments shall also include, but not be limited
16 to, assessments of information systems, computers, printers,
17 software, computer networks, interfaces to computer systems,

1 mobile and peripheral device sensors, and other devices or
2 systems which access the State's network, computer software,
3 and information processing or operational procedures of the
4 agency or of a contractor of the agency."
