SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 45/45 new

Amends the Open Operating Standards Act. Requires all State agencies that maintain an Internet website to have a web address ending in either ".gov" or ".state.il.us". Provides that an agency shall have 2 years following the effective date of this amendatory Act with which to update its website and any printed material with a proper conforming web address.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Open Operating Standards Act is amended by
5 adding Section 45 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 45/45 new)

7 Sec. 45. State agency website address. All State agencies
8 that maintain an Internet website shall have a web address
9 ending in either ".gov" or ".state.il.us". An agency shall have
10 2 years following the effective date of this amendatory Act of
11 the 100th General Assembly with which to update its website and
12 any printed material with a web address conforming to the
13 provisions of this Section.
