SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.67 new 105 ILCS 5/34-18.60 new

Amends the School Code. Requires a school board to enroll its elementary schools in the Scripps National Spelling Bee program and implement an annual district-wide spelling bee competition for students in the 7th grade. Provides that members of the public must be permitted to attend the competition, and the school district shall publish notice of the date of the competition in a newspaper of general circulation within the district. Effective July 1, 2018.

STATE MANDATES ACT MAY REQUIRE REIMBURSEMENT 1 AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 10-20.67 and 34-18.60 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 10-20.67. Seventh grade spelling bee required. The school board of each school district that maintains grades one 8 9 through 8 must enroll its elementary schools in the Scripps National Spelling Bee program and implement an annual 10 district-wide spelling bee competition for students in the 7th 11 12 grade. Members of the public must be permitted to attend the competition, and the district shall publish notice of the date 13 14 of the competition in a newspaper of general circulation within the district. 15

- Sec. 34-18.60. Seventh grade spelling bee required. The
 board must enroll its elementary schools in the Scripps
