1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4295

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 4295 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Department of Central Management Services  
5 Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by  
6 adding Section 405-413 as follows:

7 (20 ILCS 405/405-413 new)

8 Sec. 405-413. Geographic consolidation of State employment  
9 positions.

10 (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the  
11 Director of Central Management Services, working in  
12 consultation with the Director of any affected State agency,  
13 shall direct the relocation to Sangamon County of all State  
14 employment positions under the Personnel Code that are not  
15 required by their nature or function to be located in a  
16 specific geographic area.

1       (b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the  
2 Director of Central Management Services, working in  
3 consultation with the Director of any affected State agency,  
4 shall direct all new State employment positions which may be  
5 created under the Personnel Code, and which are not required by  
6 their nature or function to be located in a specific geographic  
7 area, to be located in Sangamon County.

8       (c) The Director shall determine a geographic location for  
9 each State employment position and, if it is other than  
10 Sangamon County, the reason for it to be in that geographic  
11 location. In determining whether to locate or relocate a State  
12 employment position to Sangamon County, the Director shall  
13 consult the Director of any affected State agency as to whether  
14 the nature or function of a position requires it to be located  
15 in a specific geographic area of the State. If no such  
16 geographic necessity exists, that position shall be located or  
17 relocated to Sangamon County.

18       (d) The rights of employees and the State and its agencies  
19 under the Personnel Code and applicable collective bargaining  
20 agreements with respect to the relocation of current State  
21 employee position holders shall not be affected by the  
22 provisions of this Section. The provisions of this Section  
23 regarding location or relocation of a position to Sangamon  
24 County shall apply only to State employment positions that  
25 become vacant or are created on or after the effective date of  
26 this amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly.

1       (e) The provisions of this Section do not apply to: (1) any  
2 office of the legislative or judicial branch; (2) Statewide  
3 offices under the jurisdiction of any executive branch  
4 constitutional officer other than the Governor; or (3) persons  
5 employed directly by the Office of the Governor. This Section  
6 does apply to departments and agencies of State government  
7 under the jurisdiction of the Governor other than persons  
8 employed directly by the Office of the Governor.

9       Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
10 becoming law.".
