SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Revenue Estimate Act. Provides that the General Assembly shall not enact any bill to appropriate funds within any fiscal year prior to its adoption of a joint resolution reflecting the estimate of funds available for that fiscal year as required under the Commission on Government Forecasting and Accountability Act. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning finance.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
5 Revenue Estimate Act.

6 Section 5. Passage of appropriation bills prohibited
7 before adoption of joint resolution. The General Assembly shall
8 not enact any bill to appropriate funds within any fiscal year
9 prior to its adoption of a joint resolution reflecting the
10 estimate of funds available for that fiscal year as required
11 under Section 4 of the Commission on Government Forecasting and
12 Accountability Act.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
14 becoming law.
