1 AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 10-16.5 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/10-16.5)
- Sec. 10-16.5. Oath of office. Each school board member,
- 8 before taking his or her seat on the board, shall take an oath
- 9 of office, administered as determined by the board, in
- 10 substantially the following form:
- I, (name of member or successful candidate), do
- solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will faithfully discharge
- 13 the duties of the office of member of the Board of
- 14 Education (or Board of School Directors, as the case may
- be) of (name of school district), in accordance with the
- 16 Constitution of the United States, the Constitution of the
- 17 State of Illinois, and the laws of the State of Illinois,
- 18 to the best of my ability.
- 19 I further swear (or affirm) that:
- I shall respect taxpayer interests by serving as a
- 21 faithful protector of the school district's assets;
- I shall encourage and respect the free expression of
- opinion by my fellow board members and others who seek a

3	I shall recognize that a board member has no legal
4	authority as an individual and that decisions can be made
5	only by a majority vote at a public board meeting; and
6	I shall abide by majority decisions of the board, while
7	retaining the right to seek changes in such decisions
8	through ethical and constructive channels: -
9	As part of the Board of Education (or Board of School
10	Directors, as the case may be), I shall accept the
11	responsibility for my role in the equitable and quality
12	education of every student in the school district;
13	I shall foster with the board extensive participation
14	of the community, formulate goals, define outcomes, and set
15	the course for (name of school district);
16	I shall assist in establishing a structure and an
17	environment designed to ensure all students have the
18	opportunity to attain their maximum potential through a
19	sound organizational framework;
20	I shall strive to ensure a continuous assessment of
21	student achievement and all conditions affecting the
22	education of our children, in compliance with State law;
23	I shall serve as education's key advocate on behalf of
24	students and our community's school (or schools) to advance

I shall strive to work together with the district
