### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

520 ILCS 5/3.4b new

Amends the Wildlife Code. Provides that persons licensed to possess a concealed firearm under the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and current or retired police officers authorized by law to possess a concealed firearm shall be exempt from provisions of the Code prohibiting possession of those firearms.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by adding Section  
5 3.4b as follows:

6 (520 ILCS 5/3.4b new)

7 Sec. 3.4b. Exemption. Persons licensed to possess a  
8 concealed firearm under the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and  
9 current or retired police officers authorized by law to possess  
10 a concealed firearm shall be exempt from provisions of this  
11 Code prohibiting possession of those firearms. However,  
12 nothing in this Section authorizes the use of those firearms  
13 except as authorized in the Firearm Concealed Carry Act, this  
14 Code, or other law.
