## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by changing Section 50 as follows:

- 8 (a) The Governor shall annually designate by official 9 proclamation the last Sunday in September as Gold Star Mothers' 10 Day to be observed throughout the State as a day to honor and 11 commemorate the mothers of men and women who gave their lives 12 while serving with the armed forces of the United States in
- 13 time of war or during a period of hostilities.

- Gold Star Family Day to be observed throughout the State as a
