1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 5288

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 5288 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Alcoholism and Other Drug Abuse and  
5 Dependency Act is amended by adding Section 55-35 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 301/55-35 new)

7 Sec. 55-35. Recovery residences.

8 (a) As used in this Section, "recovery residence" means a  
9 sober, safe, and healthy living environment that promotes  
10 recovery from alcohol and other drug use and associated  
11 problems. These residences are not subject to Department  
12 licensure as they are viewed as independent living residences  
13 that only provide peer support and a lengthened exposure to the  
14 culture of recovery.

15 (b) The Department shall develop and maintain an online  
16 registry for recovery residences that operate in Illinois to

1 serve as a resource for individuals seeking continued recovery  
2 assistance.

3 (c) Non-licensable recovery residences are encouraged to  
4 register with the Department and the registry shall be publicly  
5 available through online posting.

6 (d) The registry shall indicate any accreditation,  
7 certification, or licensure that each recovery residence has  
8 received from an entity that has developed uniform national  
9 standards. The registry shall also indicate each recovery  
10 residence's location in order to assist providers and  
11 individuals in finding alcohol and drug free housing options  
12 with like-minded residents who are committed to alcohol and  
13 drug free living.

14 (e) Registrants are encouraged to seek national  
15 accreditation from any entity that has developed uniform State  
16 or national standards for recovery residences.

17 (f) The Department shall include a disclaimer on the  
18 registry that states that the recovery residences are not  
19 regulated by the Department and their listing is provided as a  
20 resource but not as an endorsement by the State.

21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January  
22 1, 2019.".
