# SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/6-30005 new 65 ILCS 5/8-1-2.3 new

Amends the Counties Code and Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that a county or municipality may not use payments received from the Local Government Distributive Fund for payments for travel, lodging, or dining. Limits home rule powers. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section
6-30005 as follows:

(55 ILCS 5/6-30005 new)

7 Sec. 6-30005. Expenses for travel, lodging, or dining. A county may not use payments received from the Local Government 8 9 Distributive Fund for payments for travel, lodging, or dining. A home rule county may not use payments received from the Local 10 Government Distributive Fund in a manner inconsistent with this 11 Section. This Section is a limitation under subsection (i) of 12 Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the 13 14 concurrent exercise by home rule units of powers and functions exercised by the State. 15

Section 10. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding Section 8-1-2.3 as follows:
