 3 interior and exterior of the various buildings and facilities
 4 under the jurisdiction of the Office of the Secretary of State,
 5 including sidewalks, terraces, and grounds and all labor,
 6 materials, and other costs incidental to the above work:

8 Section 15. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital Development
 10 Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for new
 11 construction and alterations, and maintenance of the interiors
 12 and exteriors of the various buildings and facilities under the
 13 jurisdiction of the Office of the Secretary of State.

14 Section 20. The sum of \$2,672,074, or so much thereof as
 15 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business
 16 on June 30, 2018, from appropriations heretofore made for such
 17 purpose in Article 96, Section 15 and Section 20 of Public Act
 18 100-0021, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund
 19 to the Office of the Secretary of State for new construction
 20 and alterations, and maintenance of the interiors and exteriors
 21 of the various buildings and facilities under the jurisdiction
 22 of the Office of the Secretary of State.

1 Section 25. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may

13 necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the

1 Section 95. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
3 Special License Plate Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
4 State for grants to benefit Illinois Veterans Home libraries.

5 Section 100. The sum of \$43,000, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
7 of State from the Master Mason Fund to provide grants to
8 Illinois Masonic Charities Fund, a not-for-profit corporation,
9 for charitable purposes.

10 Section 105. The sum of \$75,000, or so much thereof as may
11 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
12 the Illinois Pan Hellenic Trust Fund to provide grants for
13 charitable purposes sponsored by African-American fraternities
14 and sororities.

15 Section 110. The sum of \$27,000, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
17 the Park District Youth Program Fund to provide grants for the
18 Illinois Association of Park Districts: After School
19 Programming.

20 Section 115. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may
21 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from

1 the Illinois Route 66 Heritage Project Fund to provide grants
2 for the development of tourism, education, preservation and
3 promotion of Route 66.

4 Section 120. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is appropriated from the Police Memorial
6 Committee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
7 grants to the Police Memorial Committee for maintaining a
8 memorial statue, holding an annual memorial commemoration, and
9 giving scholarships to children of police officers killed in
10 the line of duty.

11 Section 125. The sum of \$130,000, or so much thereof as may
12 be necessary, is appropriated from the Mammogram Fund to the
13 Office of the Secretary of State for grants to the Susan G.
14 Komen Foundation for breast cancer research, education,
15 screening, and treatment.

16 Section 130. The following named sum, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
18 Office of the Secretary of State for such purposes in Section
19 3-646 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5), for grants to
20 the Regional Organ Bank of Illinois and to Mid-America
21 Transplant Services for the purpose of promotion of organ and
22 tissue donation awareness. These amounts are in addition to any

1 amounts otherwise appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
2 of State:

3 From Organ Donor Awareness Fund160,000

4 Section 135. The sum of \$45,000, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
6 the Chicago Police Memorial Foundation Fund for grants to the
7 Chicago Police Memorial Foundation for maintenance of a
8 memorial and park, holding an annual memorial commemoration,
9 giving scholarships to children of police officers killed or
10 catastrophically injured in the line of duty, providing
11 financial assistance to police officers and their families when
12 a police officer is killed or injured in the line of duty, and
13 paying the insurance premiums for police officers who are
14 terminally ill.

15 Section 140. The sum of \$145,000, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
17 the U.S. Marine Corps Scholarship Fund to provide grants for
18 scholarships for Higher Education.

19 Section 145. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
20 be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS Federal Projects
21 Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for the payment
22 of any operational expenses relating to the cost incident to

1 augmenting the Illinois Commercial Motor Vehicle safety program
2 by assuring and verifying the identity of drivers prior to
3 licensure, including CDL operators; for improved security for
4 Drivers Licenses and Personal Identification Cards; and any
5 other related program deemed appropriate by the Office of the
6 Secretary of State.

7 Section 150. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
9 of State from the Securities Investors Education Fund for any
10 expenses used to promote public awareness of the dangers of
11 securities fraud.

12 Section 155. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may
13 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
14 of State from the Secretary of State Evidence Fund for the
15 purchase of evidence, for the employment of persons to obtain
16 evidence, and for the payment for any goods or services related
17 to obtaining evidence.

18 Section 160. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as may
19 be necessary, is appropriated from the Alternate Fuels Fund to
20 the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of administering
21 the Alternate Fuels Act.

1 Section 165. The sum of \$16,000,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
3 Special Services Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State
4 for office automation and technology.

5 Section 170. The sum of \$16,000,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Motor Vehicle
7 License Plate Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
8 the cost incident to providing new or replacement plates for
9 motor vehicles.

10 Section 175. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
12 DUI Administration Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for
13 operation of the Department of Administrative Hearings of the
14 Office of Secretary of State and for no other purpose.

15 Section 180. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
17 Police DUI Fund to the Secretary of State for the payments of
18 goods and services that will assist in the prevention of
19 alcohol-related criminal violence throughout the State.

20 Section 185. The sum of \$700,000, or so much thereof as may
21 be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State

1 Police Services Fund to the Secretary of State for purposes as
2 indicated by the grantor or contractor or, in the case of money
3 bequeathed or granted for no specific purpose, for any purpose
4 as deemed appropriate by the Director of Police, Secretary of
5 State in administering the responsibilities of the Secretary
6 of State Department of Police.

7 Section 190. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary, is appropriated from the Office of the Secretary
9 of State Grant Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State to
10 be expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon
11 which such funds were received.

12 Section 195. The sum of \$24,300, or so much thereof as may
13 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
14 of State from the State Library Fund to increase the collection
15 of books, records, and holdings; to hold public forums; to
16 purchase equipment and resource materials for the State
17 Library; and for the upkeep, repair, and maintenance of the
18 State Library building and grounds.

19 Section 200. The following sum, or so much thereof as may
20 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
21 of State for any operations, alterations, rehabilitations, new
22 construction, and maintenance of the interior and exterior of

1 the various buildings and facilities under the jurisdiction of
2 the Secretary of State to enhance security measures in the
3 Capitol Complex:

4 From General Revenue Fund4,000,000

5 Section 205. The sum of \$13,500,000, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of
7 State Identification Security and Theft Prevention Fund to the
8 Office of Secretary of State for all costs related to
9 implementing identification security and theft prevention
10 measures.

11 Section 210. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
13 of State from the Driver Services Administration Fund for the
14 payment of costs related to the issuance of temporary visitor's
15 driver's licenses, and other operational costs, including
16 personnel, facilities, computer programming, and data
17 transmission.

18 Section 215. The sum of \$2,200,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Monitoring Device
20 Driving Permit Administration Fee Fund to the Office of the
21 Secretary of State for all Secretary of State costs associated

1 with administering Monitoring Device Driving Permits per Public
2 Act 95-0400.

3 Section 220. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Indigent BAIID Fund
5 to the Office of the Secretary of State to reimburse ignition
6 interlock device providers per Public Act 95-0400, including
7 reimbursements submitted in prior years.

8 Section 225. The sum of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
10 of State from the Motor Vehicle Theft Prevention and Insurance
11 Verification Trust Fund for awards, grants, and operational
12 support to implement the Illinois Motor Vehicle Theft
13 Prevention and Insurance Verification Act, and for operational
14 expenses of the Office to implement the Act.

15 Section 230. The sum of \$75,000, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
17 the Illinois Professional Golfers Association Junior Golf Fund
18 for grants to the Illinois Professional Golfers Association
19 Foundation to help Association members expose Illinois
20 youngsters to the game of golf.

1 Section 235. The sum of \$110,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
3 from the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund for grants to support
4 Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public and private
5 schools within Illinois.

6 Section 240. The sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as may
7 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
8 the Boy Scout and Girl Scout Fund for grants to the Illinois
9 divisions of the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl Scouts of
10 the U.S.A.

11 Section 245. The sum of \$75,000, or so much thereof as may
12 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
13 the Support Our Troops Fund for grants to Illinois Support Our
14 Troops, Inc. for charitable assistance to the troops and their
15 families in accordance with its Articles of Incorporation.

16 Section 250. The sum of \$4,000, or so much thereof as may
17 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
18 of State from the Rotary Club Fund for grants for charitable
19 purposes sponsored by the Rotary Club.

20 Section 255. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may
21 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary

1 of State from the Ovarian Cancer Awareness Fund for grants to
2 the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition, Inc. for ovarian cancer
3 research, education, screening, and treatment.

4 Section 260. The sum of \$6,000, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
6 of State from the Sheet Metal Workers International Association
7 of Illinois Fund for grants for charitable purposes sponsored
8 by Illinois chapters of the Sheet Metal Workers International
9 Association.

10 Section 265. The sum of \$110,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
12 of State from the Illinois Police Association Fund for
13 providing death benefits for the families of police officers
14 killed in the line of duty, and for providing scholarships, for
15 graduate study, undergraduate study, or both, to children and
16 spouses of police officers killed in the line of duty.

17 Section 270. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may
18 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
19 the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Fund for grants to
20 the Teamsters Joint Council 25 Charitable Trust for religious,
21 charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes.

1 Section 275. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
3 of State from the Fraternal Order of Police Fund for grants to
4 the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police to increase the
5 efficiency and professionalism of law enforcement officers in
6 Illinois, to educate the public about law enforcement issues,
7 to more firmly establish the public confidence in law
8 enforcement, to create partnerships with the public, and to
9 honor the service of law enforcement officers.

10 Section 280. The sum of \$45,000, or so much thereof as may
11 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
12 the Share the Road Fund for grants to the League of Illinois
13 Bicyclists, a not for profit corporation, for educational
14 programs instructing bicyclists and motorists how to legally
15 and more safely share the roadways.

16 Section 285. The sum of \$3,500, or so much thereof as may
17 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
18 of State from the St. Jude Children's Research Fund for grants
19 to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital for pediatric
20 treatment and research.

21 Section 290. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as may
22 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary

1 of State from the Ducks Unlimited Fund for grants to Ducks
2 Unlimited, Inc. to fund wetland protection, enhancement, and
3 restoration projects in the State of Illinois, to fund
4 education and outreach for media, volunteers, members, and the
5 general public regarding waterfowl and wetlands conservation
6 in the State of Illinois, and to cover reasonable cost for
7 Ducks Unlimited plate advertising and administration of the
8 wetland conservation projects and education program.

9 Section 295. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
11 the Family Responsibility Fund for all costs associated with
12 enforcement of the Family Financial Responsibility Law.

13 Section 300. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as may
14 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
15 of State from the Illinois State Police Memorial Park Fund for
16 grants to the Illinois State Police Heritage Foundation, Inc.
17 for building and maintaining a memorial and park, holding an
18 annual memorial commemoration, giving scholarships to children
19 of State police officers killed or catastrophically injured in
20 the line of duty, and providing financial assistance to police
21 officers and their families when a police officer is killed
22 or injured in the line of duty.

1 Section 305. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
3 of State from the Illinois Sheriffs' Association Scholarship
4 and Training Fund for grants to the Illinois Sheriffs'
5 Association for scholarships obtained in a competitive process
6 to attend the Illinois Teen Institute or an accredited college
7 or university, for programs designed to benefit the elderly and
8 teens, and for law enforcement training.

9 Section 310. The sum of \$15,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
11 of State from the Alzheimer's Awareness Fund for grants to the
12 Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders Association, Greater
13 Illinois Chapter, for Alzheimer's care, support, education, and
14 awareness programs.

15 Section 315. The sum of \$40,000, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
17 of State from the Illinois Nurses Foundation Fund for grants
18 to the Illinois Nurses Foundation, to promote the health of the
19 public by advancing the nursing profession in this State.

20 Section 320. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may
21 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
22 of State from the Hospice Fund for grants to a statewide

1 organization whose primary membership consists of hospice
2 programs.

3 Section 325. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
5 of State from the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund for
6 grants to the Rantoul Historical Society and Museum, or any
7 other charitable foundation responsible for the former exhibits
8 and collections of the Chanute Air Museum, for operational and
9 program expenses of the Chanute Air Museum and any other
10 structure housing exhibits and collections of the Chanute Air
11 Museum.

12 Section 330. The sum of \$1,200, or so much thereof as may
13 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
14 of State from the National Wild Turkey Federation Fund for
15 grants to fund turkey habitat protection enhancement and
16 restoration projects in the State of Illinois, to fund
17 education and outreach for media, volunteers, members and the
18 general public regarding turkeys and turkey habitat
19 conservation in the State of Illinois and to cover the
20 reasonable cost for National Wild Turkey Federation special
21 plate advertising and administration of the conservation
22 projects and education programs.

1 Section 335. The sum of \$5,800, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
3 of State from the Curing Childhood Cancer Fund for grants in
4 equal shares to the St. Jude Children's Research Hospital and
5 the Children's Oncology Group for the purpose of making
6 scientific research on cancer.

7 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
8 2018.
