2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 5

5 Section 5-5. The following amounts, or so much of those  
6 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
7 from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Elections  
8 for its ordinary and contingent expenses as follows:

1 Compensation to Judges and other Election  
2 Officials, as provided in Public Acts  
3 81-850, 81-1149, and 90-672-Election  
4 Day Judges only .....5,000,000  
5 For Payment of Lump Sum Awards to County Clerks,  
6 County Recorders, and Chief Election  
7 Clerks as Compensation for Additional

 2 grants to Local Election Authorities  
 3 under Section 101 of the Help America  
 4 Vote Act .....350,000  
 5 Total \$3,046,000

6 Total, This Article (All Agency):  
 7 Payable from the General Revenue Fund .....16,592,300  
 8 Payable from the Personal Property  
 9 Tax Replacement Fund .....5,799,500

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
 13 2018.
