HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT HC0015

Introduced , by Rep. Steven A. Andersson

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 2.5 new ILCON Art. V, Sec. 2

Proposes to amend the Legislature and Executive Articles of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that a person may not hold the office of State Senator or State Representative for more than 12 years, or a combination of those offices for more than 16 years. Provides that a person may not serve more than 2 terms within the Office of the Governor. Provides that a person may not serve more than 3 terms within the same Executive Branch office.

11	ARTICLE IV
12	THE LEGISLATURE
13	(ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 2.5 new)
14	SECTION 2.5. TERM LIMITS. A person may not hold the office of
15	State Senator or State Representative for more than 12 years,
16	or a combination of those offices for more than 16 years.
17	Service before the second Wednesday in January of 2019 shall
18	not be considered in the calculation of a person's service.
19	ARTICLE V
20	THE EXECUTIVE

- SECTION 2. TERMS
- 2 (a) These elected officers of the Executive Branch shall
- 3 hold office for four years beginning on the second Monday of
- 4 January after their election and, except in the case of the
- 5 Lieutenant Governor, until their successors are qualified.
- 6 They shall be elected at the general election in 1978 and every
- 7 four years thereafter.
- 8 (b) A person may not serve more than 2 terms within the
- 9 office of the Governor.
- 10 (c) A person may not serve more than 3 terms within the
- 11 same Executive Branch office. A person is considered to serve a
- term of office for the purpose of this subsection if the person
- is elected or appointed to serve any portion of the term.
