AMENDMENT TO HOUSE RESOLUTION 765 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_. Amend House Resolution 765 by replacing everything after the heading with the following: "WHEREAS, Agricultural productivity in the United States is growing faster than domestic demand; and WHEREAS, U.S. farmers and agricultural firms rely heavily

on export markets to sustain adequate prices for agricultural products with as much as one in three bushels of U.S. corn exported in some form and as much as one in two bushels of soybeans exported in some form; and

11 WHEREAS, A large amount of the corn and soybeans grown in 12 Illinois is destined for the export markets, making those 13 markets a critical factor in the economic success of Illinois 14 soybean and corn farmers; and HR0765HAM001

1 WHEREAS, As much as 20 percent of Illinois farmland is 2 planted with crops destined to feed Canada, Mexico, and the 3 North American market; this farmland is crucial to Illinois 4 producers and is aided by the North American Free Trade 5 Agreement (NAFTA); and

6 WHEREAS, Illinois is the largest exporting state in the 7 Midwest and the fifth largest exporting state in the nation; 8 and

9 WHEREAS, The North American market is especially crucial to 10 corn and soybean exports, with Mexico taking over 534 million 11 bushels of US corn worth \$2.5 billion and over 195 million 12 bushels of US soy, also worth \$2.5 billion last marketing year; 13 and

14 WHEREAS, Canada is the top export market for US ethanol, 15 which is corn based; it is the third largest export market for 16 US soybean meal, and it is the fourth market for US pork, which 17 consumes 25 percent of US corn and soybean meal; and

18 WHEREAS, Mexico is a top destination for 19 Illinois-produced, dried distillers' grains, a high-value 20 livestock feed and co-product of Illinois ethanol production; 21 and HR0765HAM001

WHEREAS, The US exports of agricultural products, and many
 Illinois agricultural products, are greatly aided by the North
 American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA); and

WHEREAS, Mexico and Canada represent more than a third of
US pork exports and the loss of NAFTA would amount to a loss of
five percent of US pork production; and

7 WHEREAS, The Trump Administration is currently in 8 negotiations to redraft NAFTA and make changes to the 9 agreement; therefore be it;

10 RESOLVED, BY THE ILLINOIS HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 11 100TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge 12 our Congressional delegation to work to ensure that any 13 modifications made to NAFTA do not endanger or harm the strong 14 export market that Illinois enjoys with our neighbors to the 15 North and South; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be provided to 17 members of the Illinois Congressional Delegation."
