- 7 WHEREAS, Students with delayed development, disabilities,
 8 or limited preschool experiences, who attend rigorous and
 9 nurturing full-day programs, are more likely to have stronger
 10 achievements in basic skill areas and are generally better
 11 prepared for first grade; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Full-day kindergarten programs can help increase 13 academic achievement for most children, while reducing the 14 probability that children will be retained in the early 15 elementary grades; therefore, be it
