1 HOUSE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, A spelling bee is a competition in which 2 3 contestants are asked to spell a broad selection of words, 4 usually with a varying degree of difficulty; and WHEREAS, Spelling bees help to promote literacy by 5 providing children with a positive goal to achieve and a forum 6 7 to display the fruits of their hard work; and 8 WHEREAS, In addition to improving spelling, spelling bees 9 also aid children in learning concepts, improving comprehension, and developing study skills; and 10 11 WHEREAS, The benefits of spelling bees extend beyond 12 language; and 13 WHEREAS, Students are required to spell words while in front of an audience; children also develop self confidence, 14 communication and public speaking skills, and the ability to 15 16 thrive under pressure; and 17 WHEREAS, Participating in a spelling bee teaches children lessons that can last a lifetime and can benefit even those who 18 19 do not outlast all competitors; and
