1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of Sister 4 Lydia Mary Yokiel, C.R., who passed away on May 7, 2018, at the 5 age of 104; and

WHEREAS, Sister Yokiel was born in Wells, Minnesota on July 22, 1913; she entered the Congregation of the Sisters of the Resurrection in August of 1931; she earned degrees in education and biology and studied in Rome for a year at Regina Mundi; and

WHEREAS, Sister Yokiel taught and served as a principal in grade schools and high schools for 54 years; for 16 years she served at Resurrection College Prep High School as a biology teacher and as principal; she was instrumental in the planning of the current high school building that opened in 1962 and worked closely with the parents clubs and other community groups to raise funds for building the school and for continuing updates and modernization; after spending 54 years in education, she became a hospital chaplain and spent another 16 years ministering at Our Lady of the Resurrection and Resurrection Medical Centers; and

WHEREAS, Sister Yokiel always held Resurrection College Prep High School close to her heart and supported the school in
