ordinance or a stormwater management ordinance under

1	subsection (g) that has been approved by the Office of
2	Water Resources of the Department of Natural Resources; and
3	(2) designate a certified floodplain manager who has
4	been certified by the Association of State Floodplain
5	Managers; however, nothing in this paragraph (2) requires a
6	county to create a new position or designate another
7	individual if the county already has a certified floodplain
8	manager on staff.
9	If a county fails to continually meet any of the conditions
10	of this subsection (i-5) after approval of a referendum
11	question for an annual tax, the county may not levy a tax under
12	subsection (i) until they are in full compliance with this
