#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1805/22

from Ch. 129, par. 220.22

Amends the Military Code of Illinois. In a provision requiring the Adjutant General to order Illinois National Guard personnel into active service as required by the Commander-in-Chief to support non-emergency functions of the State, provides that the Adjutant General shall perform this duty subject to the availability of funds (rather than subject to the appropriation of funds by the General Assembly for this purpose). Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Military Code of Illinois is amended by  
5 changing Section 22 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 1805/22) (from Ch. 129, par. 220.22)

7 Sec. 22. Adjutant General; duties. The Adjutant General  
8 shall be charged with carrying out the policies of the  
9 Commander-in-Chief and shall issue orders in his name. Orders  
10 of the Adjutant General shall be considered as emanating from  
11 the Commander-in-Chief.

12 (a) He shall be the immediate adviser of the  
13 Commander-in-Chief on all matters relating to the militia and  
14 shall be charged with the planning, development and execution  
15 of the program of the military forces of the State. He shall be  
16 responsible for the preparation and execution of plans, for  
17 organizing, supplying, equipping and mobilizing the Organized  
18 Militia, for use in the national defense, and for State  
19 defense, and emergencies.

20 (b) He shall hold major organization commanders  
21 responsible for the training of their commands, and shall issue  
22 all orders and instructions for the government of the militia  
23 and of the officers, warrant officers, and enlisted personnel

1       therein.

2           (c) He shall make such returns and reports as may be  
3 prescribed by the Commander-in-Chief or required by the laws or  
4 regulations of the State or of the United States.

5           (d) He shall, subject to the availability ~~appropriation~~ of  
6 funds ~~by the General Assembly for this purpose~~, order such  
7 personnel of the Illinois National Guard into active service of  
8 the State as are required by the Commander-in-Chief to support  
9 non-emergency functions of the State, including but not limited  
10 to National Guard involvement in training exercises conducted  
11 in conjunction with the Illinois Emergency Management Agency.  
12 Illinois National Guard personnel placed on duty pursuant to  
13 this item (d) shall be paid in accordance with the provisions  
14 of Sections 48 and 49.

15           (e) The Adjutant General shall be the head of the  
16 Department of Military Affairs of the Executive Branch of the  
17 government of the State and shall be the Commander of the  
18 Illinois National Guard.

20           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
21 becoming law.
