

100TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2017 and 2018 SB1595

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Pregnancy Help Center Referral Act. Provides that a person may not perform an abortion unless the person first provides the pregnant woman with the name, address, and telephone number of an organization that:
(1) is within reasonable proximity of the abortion facility where the abortion will be performed; (2) has as one of its principal missions to provide education, counseling, and other assistance to help a pregnant mother maintain her relationship with and care for her unborn child; and (3) does not perform abortions, is not affiliated with any physician or entity that performs abortions, and does not refer pregnant mothers for abortions. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning pregnancy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Pregnancy Help Center Referral Act.
- 6 Section 5. Referral required.
- 7 (a) A person may not perform an abortion unless the person 8 first provides the pregnant woman with the name, address, and 9 telephone number of an organization that:
- 10 (1) is within reasonable proximity of the abortion 11 facility where the abortion will be performed;
 - (2) has as one of its principal missions to provide education, counseling, and other assistance to help a pregnant mother maintain her relationship with and care for her unborn child; and
 - (3) does not perform abortions, is not affiliated with any physician or entity that performs abortions, and does not refer pregnant mothers for abortions.
- 19 (b) As used in this Act, the term "abortion" has the
 20 meaning provided in Section 2 of the Illinois Abortion Law of
 21 1975.
- 22 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
