1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2046

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2046 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Income Tax Act is amended by  
5 adding Section 507GGG as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 5/507GGG new)

7 Sec. 507GGG. State Police Memorial checkoff.

8 (a) For taxable years ending on or after December 31, 2017,  
9 the Department must print on its standard individual income tax  
10 form a provision (i) indicating that if the taxpayer wishes to  
11 contribute to the Criminal Justice Information Projects Fund,  
12 as authorized by this amendatory Act of the 100th General  
13 Assembly, he or she may do so by stating the amount of the  
14 contribution (not less than \$1) on the return and (ii) stating  
15 that the contribution will reduce the taxpayer's refund or  
16 increase the amount of payment to accompany the return. Failure

1 to remit any amount of increased payment shall reduce the  
2 contribution accordingly. This Section does not apply to any  
3 amended return.

4 (b) Moneys deposited into the Criminal Justice Information  
5 Projects Fund under this Section shall be distributed equally,  
6 as soon as practical but at least on a monthly basis, to the  
7 Chicago Police Memorial Foundation Fund, the Police Memorial  
8 Committee Fund, and the Illinois State Police Memorial Fund.  
9 Moneys transferred to the funds shall be used, subject to  
10 appropriation, to fund grants for building and maintaining  
11 memorials and parks; holding annual memorial commemorations;  
12 giving scholarships to children of officers killed or  
13 catastrophically injured in the line of duty, or those  
14 interested in pursuing a career in law enforcement; and  
15 providing financial assistance to police officers and their  
16 families when a police officer is killed or injured in the line  
17 of duty."
