#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of State Police for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, as follows:

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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
7 Department of State Police for the following purposes:

15 Section 10. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Asset  
 17 Forfeiture Fund to the Department of State Police for payment  
 18 of their expenditures as outlined in the Illinois Drug Asset  
 19 Forfeiture Procedure Act, the Cannabis Control Act, the  
 20 Controlled Substances Act, and the Environmental Safety Act.

21 Section 15. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as  
 22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Asset  
 23 Forfeiture Fund to the Department of State Police for payment

1 of their expenditures in accordance with the Federal Equitable  
2 Sharing Guidelines.

3 Section 20. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as  
4 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
5 Police, Division of Administration, from the Money Laundering  
6 Asset Recovery Fund for the ordinary and contingent expenses  
7 incurred by the Department of State Police.

8 Section 25. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as  
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the LEADS Maintenance  
10 Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of  
11 Administration, for expenses related to the LEADS System.

12 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
14 Department of State Police for the following purposes:

19 Section 35. The following amount, or so much thereof as  
 20 may be necessary for objects and purposes hereinafter named,  
 21 are appropriated from the Drug Traffic Prevention Fund to the  
 22 Department of State Police, Division of Operations, pursuant  
 23 to the provisions of the "Intergovernmental Drug Laws  
 24 Enforcement Act" for Grants to Metropolitan Enforcement Groups.

1       For Grants to Metropolitan Enforcement Groups:  
 2           Payable from the Drug Traffic  
 3           Prevention Fund .....500,000

4       Section 45. The sum of \$14,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police  
 6 Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the Department of  
 7 State Police for payment of their expenditures for state law  
 8 enforcement purposes in accordance with the State Whistleblower  
 9 Protection Act.

10       Section 50. The sum of \$22,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police  
 12 Operations Assistance Fund to the Department of State Police  
 13 for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred by the  
 14 Department of State Police.

15       Section 55. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may  
 16 be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police Streetgang-  
 17 Related Crime Fund to the Department of State Police for  
 18 operations related to streetgang-related Crime Initiatives.

19       Section 60. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Over Dimensional  
 21 Load Police Escort Fund to the Department of State Police for

1 expenses incurred for providing police escorts for over-  
2 dimensional loads.

3 Section 70. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may  
4 be necessary, is appropriated from the Medicaid Fraud and Abuse  
5 Prevention Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of  
6 Operations for the detection, investigation or prosecution of  
7 recipient or vendor fraud.

8 Section 75. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
9 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
10 Department of State Police for the following purposes:

11 Section 80. The sum of \$6,250,000, or so much thereof as  
 12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
 13 Police, Division of Forensic Services and Identification, from  
 14 the Mental Health Reporting Fund for expenses as outlined in  
 15 the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and the Firearm Owners  
 16 Identification Card Act.

17 Section 85. The sum of \$22,000,000, or so much thereof  
 18 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
 19 Police from the State Police Firearm Services Fund for expenses  
 20 as outlined in the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and the Firearm  
 21 Owners Identification Card Act.

22 Section 90. The following amounts, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
2 Department of State Police for Internal Investigation expenses  
3 as follows:

5 Payable from the General Revenue Fund:

17 Section 95. The sum of \$717,900, or so much thereof as may  
18 be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
19 Police, Division of Internal Investigation, from the General  
20 Revenue Fund for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred  
21 while operating the Nursing Home Identified Offender Program.

22 Section 100. The sum of \$140,000,000, or so much thereof  
23 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1

1 Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of  
2 Administration, for costs pursuant to the Emergency Telephone  
3 System Act.

4 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July  
5 1, 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General  
6 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced  
7 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
