### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/22-32 new

Amends the School Code. Requires a school district to allow a student to possess and use a topical sunscreen product while on school property or at a school-related event or activity, regardless of the student possessing a note or prescription from a licensed health care professional. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section  
5 22-32 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/22-32 new)

7 Sec. 22-32. Student possession and use of sunscreen. A  
8 school district shall allow a student to possess and use a  
9 topical sunscreen product while on school property or at a  
10 school-related event or activity, regardless of the student  
11 possessing a note or prescription from a licensed health care  
12 professional.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
14 becoming law.
