SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 10/6.5 new

Amends the Illinois School Student Records Act. Provides that upon the discovery of a breach of security that results in the unauthorized release, disclosure, or acquisition of student information contained in a school student record, a school shall, no later than 48 hours after discovery, notify the parent of the student whose record is involved in the breach of security. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois School Student Records Act is
5 amended by adding Section 6.5 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 10/6.5 new)

7 Sec. 6.5. Security breach. Upon the discovery of a breach
8 of security that results in the unauthorized release,
9 disclosure, or acquisition of student information contained in
10 a school student record, a school shall, no later than 48 hours
11 after discovery, notify the parent of the student whose record
12 is involved in the breach of security.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
14 becoming law.
