The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may 6 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Fire Fighters' 7 Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for 8 related to the maintenance of the Illinois expenses 9 Firefighters' Memorial, holding the annual Fallen Firefighter 10 Ceremony, and other expenses as allowed under Public Act 91-11 0832.

1 Section 60. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to 3 the Office of the State Fire Marshal for a grant to the 4 Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Reimbursement.

5 Section 65. The sum of \$550,000, or so much thereof as may 6 be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Storage Tank 7 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for a grant to the 8 City of Chicago for administrative costs incurred as a result 9 of the State's Underground Storage Program.

10 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1, 11 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary, 12 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all 13 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
