#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the following purposes: ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office; ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program; statewide training for Public Defenders; development of a Juvenile Defender Resource Center; and expenses related to federally assisted programs. Effective July 1, 2018.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of those  
5 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and  
6 purposes named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
7 to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of  
8 the State Appellate Defender:

9	For Personal Services .....	\$17,007,600
10	For State Contributions to Social Security .....	\$1,300,500
11	For Contractual Services .....	\$2,658,000
12	For Travel .....	\$35,000
13	For Commodities .....	\$27,000
14	For Printing .....	\$28,000
15	For Equipment .....	\$28,000
16	For EDP .....	\$1,091,700
17	For Telecommunications .....	\$85,000
18	For Law Student Program .....	<u>\$65,000</u>
19	Total .....	\$22,325,800

20 Section 10. The amount of \$120,000, or so much thereof as  
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
22 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary

1 and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

2 Section 15. The amount \$70,000, or so much thereof as may  
3 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to  
4 the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide statewide  
5 training to Public Defenders under the Public Defender Training  
6 Program.

7 Section 20. The amount of \$305,000, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
9 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a  
10 Juvenile Defender Resource Center.

11 Section 25. The amount of \$150,000, or so much thereof as  
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Appellate  
13 Defender Federal Trust Fund to the Office of the State Appellate  
14 Defender for expenses related to federally assisted programs.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
16 2018.
