1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, It is highly fitting that the Illinois General  
3 Assembly pays honor and respect to the truly great individuals  
4 who have served their communities; and

5 WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Adam V. Streicher dreamed of being  
6 a police officer at a young age; he started as a Police  
7 Explorer in high school and later attended college to earn a  
8 criminal justice degree while working as a Code Enforcer for  
9 the City of Kewanee; and

10 WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Adam Streicher worked for the  
11 Villages of Atkinson, Sheffield, and Annawan, which was his  
12 hometown, before accepting employment as a Sheriff's Deputy for  
13 Stark County in 2001; and

14 WHEREAS, On March 22, 2002, Deputy Sheriff Adam Streicher  
15 was shot and killed while attempting to serve a failure to pay  
16 warrant; and

17 WHEREAS, Deputy Sheriff Adam Streicher attended Annawan  
18 High School along with other fallen police officers Master  
19 Sergeant Stanley W. Talbot and Michigan State Trooper Chad H.  
20 Wolf; therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH GENERAL  
2 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
3 CONCURRING HEREIN, that we designate the Illinois Route 78  
4 overpass over Interstate 80 as the Deputy Sheriff Adam V.  
5 Streicher, Master Sergeant Stanley W. Talbot, and Trooper Chad  
6 H. Wolf Memorial Overpass; and be it further

7           RESOLVED, That the Illinois Department of Transportation  
8 is requested to erect at suitable locations, consistent with  
9 State and federal regulations, appropriate plaques or signs  
10 giving notice of the name of the Deputy Sheriff Adam V.  
11 Streicher, Master Sergeant Stanley W. Talbot, and Trooper Chad  
12 H. Wolf Memorial Overpass; and be it further

13           RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be  
14 delivered to the Secretary of the Illinois Department of  
15 Transportation and the families of Deputy Sheriff Adam V.  
16 Streicher, Master Sergeant Stanley W. Talbot, and Trooper Chad  
17 H. Wolf.
