1 SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, An efficient building maintains moderate
3 temperatures, low humidity, and increased air quality; and

4 WHEREAS, Energy efficient buildings use less energy, cost
5 less to operate, and produce fewer greenhouse gasses; and

6 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois operates hundreds of
7 buildings throughout the State, including buildings built
8 decades ago; therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH GENERAL
10 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the Department
11 of Central Management Services to partner with the Illinois
12 Regional Insulator Contractors Association to conduct energy
13 efficiency audits at five State buildings at no charge to the
14 State; and be it further

15 RESOLVED, That the Department of Central Management
16 Services and the Illinois Regional Insulator Contractors
17 Association conduct these audits around the State, if possible,
18 in Chicago, Cook County, DuPage County, Kane County, Lake
19 County, McHenry or Will County, Central Illinois, and Southern
20 Illinois; and be it further

1 RESOLVED, That the energy efficiency audit be in accordance
2 with the 3E plus system and may consider the study of all of
3 the following for each real property: (1) the efficiency of
4 equipment located at the real property; (2) the use of heating,
5 ventilation, and air conditioning; (3) the use of energy for
6 lighting; (4) maintenance procedures; and (5) the cost of
7 alternate sources of energy for any energy used; and be it
8 further

9 RESOLVED, That the energy efficiency audit may include: (1)
10 recommendations on methods to conserve energy; (2) an estimate
11 of the time necessary to implement any recommended changes; and
12 (3) projected costs of any capital improvement necessary to
13 reduce energy costs; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That the Department of Central Management
15 Services shall post a copy of the audits on the Department's
16 website.
