- 2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Jo Ann Marie Robinson of Bolingbrook, who 4 passed away in April of 2017; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Jo Ann Robinson was born in Bolingbrook on June 6 27, 1956; she graduated from DuSable High School; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Jo Ann Robinson served in prison ministry from 8 1993 to 1998; she hosted an award-winning cable show, "From the 9 Heart Show"; and
- Jo 10 WHEREAS, Ann Robinson founded the H.E.A.R.T. 11 Organization Community Service Program in 1999 and served as 12 its director; participants in the program are affectionately 13 known throughout her community as the "Spiritual Boot Camp Soldiers"; the program has assisted thousands of children, 14 helping them avoid prosecution and convictions; it has been 15 16 featured in the Joliet Herald, the Bolingbrook Sun, and The 17 Patch Newspaper; and
- WHEREAS, Jo Ann Robinson was awarded the "John F.
  Whiteside" lifetime achievement award from the Will County
  Sheriff's Department, the "National Chiefs of Police
  Citation", and the "Seekers of Justice Award" from the Black

- 1 Bar Association in 2012; she was voted "Citizen of the Year" by
- 2 Mayor Roger Claar, and honored by the American Association of
- 3 University Women as the "Distinguished Woman the Year"; in 2005
- and 2006, she received the AT&T "Beyond the Call" award; she
- 5 was awarded "Female Citizen of the Year" by DuPage Township,
- 6 and was honored by the DuPage AME Church for her work with
- 7 at-risk youth; therefore, be it
