WHEREAS, Officer Jones was a veteran of the Elgin Police Department and a school resource officer at Kimball Middle School; he worked for 28 years making Elgin a better place to live; he was well known throughout Elgin, where he spent his entire career after being hired in 1989; and

WHEREAS, Officer Jones worked patrol for many years and was a member of the department's drug unit and the multijurisdictional North Central Narcotics Task Force; and

WHEREAS, Officer Jones ran a mentoring program for kids, connecting them with people he knew in the community; he helped organize the "community conversations" series held between police and residents at Second Baptist Church of Elgin; he was active with the National Organization of Black Law Enforcement Executives; and

WHEREAS, Officer Jones earned 16 letters of appreciation, a

5 School by Jarrett Payton, son of the late Walter Payton, the

8 students and staff at Kimball Middle School in Elgin; many of
9 the students described him as amazing, legendary, and some even
10 said he was a father figure to them; he was very approachable
11 and took many of the younger officers under his wing sharing
