- 2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Allison "Al" Perring Jr. of Clinton, who 4 passed away on September 27, 2017; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Al Perring was born in Midland City to Allison Sr. 6 and Margaret Cox Perring on August 19, 1931; he married Jean 7 Gehlbach in Waynesville on December 29, 1950; and
- WHEREAS, Al Perring served in the United States Army and 8 9 was a veteran of the Korean War; after his military service, he 10 returned to Central Illinois and began a life of farming; even though he faced his share of crop losses, machinery breakdowns, 11 12 and wide fluctuations in market prices, he never questioned his 13 decision, and he never thought of being anything other than a 14 farmer; throughout his career, he maintained a positive attitude and an optimistic outlook on the future of farming; 15 16 and
- WHEREAS, Al Perring's optimism caught the attention of the Salute to Agriculture Program, and he was a finalist for their Farmer of the Year Award; and

- 2 President, and the Nixon Township supervisor; he was a 4-H
- 3 leader and a Little League coach and official; he was a 33rd
- 4 degree Mason; and

- 6 farming, and Fighting Illini sports; he was a loving husband,
- 7 father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, and friend
- 8 whose legacy lives on through his family and community; and

- 10 his four brothers; and his sisters; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Al Perring is survived by his wife of 66 years,
- Jean; his children, David Perring, Steve (Lee Ann) Perring, and
- 13 Kathy (Ted) Parge; his six grandchildren; his eight
- 14 great-grandchildren and one on the way; and his sister-in-law,
